“Woodblock printing is a technique for printing text, images or patterns used widely throughout East Asia and originating in China...as a method of printing on textiles and later paper. In this method of printing an image is carved into the surface of a piece of wood, which is then inked, and the image is stamped onto a page.” Framers always show the edges of the printed area so that it is clear that the art is a woodblock. Melissa Schambs framed this cheerful woodblock by an American artist, Kent Ambler, for her home in Raleigh.
